# **LOGISTICS NOTE**

We are delighted to warmly welcome you to Uganda for the National Conference on What Works in Girls' Education. This conference that will be held under the theme, "Breaking Barriers, Building Futures: Evidence & Action for Girls' Education" is scheduled for 1st – 3rd October, 2025, at Hilton Garden Inn, Kampala, Uganda.

### TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

Uganda offers an **e-visa system** for most travelers. If you have not yet applied for a visa, you can do so through the official e-visa portal <a href="https://visas.immigration.go.ug">https://visas.immigration.go.ug</a>. You will be required to fill in an online application and upload the required documents. Upon approval, you will receive an electronic visa approval letter to present upon arrival. Please check the e-visa portal to confirm if you require a visa to Uganda and request for an invitation letter by emailing the organising team at: <a href="mailto:info@uwezouganda.org">info@uwezouganda.org</a>

Citizens from the East African Community do not require a visa to enter Uganda.

**Yellow Fever Card:** Remember to carry your vaccination cards, and particularly your yellow fever card.

**Invitation Letter**: Remember to carry your invitation letter either in digital or print form.

## TRANSPORT, ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

#### **Transport**

All participants are responsible for their airport transfers and transport to the conference venue, for those who are not residing at the conference venue.

Transport from Entebbe airport to Kampala is approximately \$40-50.

### Accommodation

#### **WEATHER**

October weather in Uganda is typically warm and humid, with average temperatures ranging from 18-28°C (64-82°F). Delegates are advised to pack accordingly.

This period marks the start of the short rainy season, so visitors can expect a mix of sunshine and occasional showers. The rains are usually brief and light, leaving plenty of time to enjoy clear skies.

For comfort, we recommend packing light, breathable clothing for the day, along with a light sweater or jacket for the cooler evenings and early mornings.

#### **SAFETY**

It is advisable to avoid walking alone in isolated places and back streets both during the day and night. Avoid displaying valuables and minimise the use of your mobile phone while walking on the streets. At the hotel, familiarise yourself with the fire exits, especially those on your floor and know where they come out.

This is the number one place to visit. You'll be amazed at Uganda's diverse cultural heritage illustrated through artefacts, exhibits and informative guides at this small museum.

Distance from the conference venue- Hilton Garden Inn – half a kilometer (km)

Explore the splendid traditional hut and meet the ancestors of long-gone Kabakas (kings) of Buganda Kingdom. No advance bookings are needed and on-site guides are ready to welcome you. Did you know you can make cloth from a tree? On the Experiential Trail of Buganda, watch the age-old skill of barkcloth-making, take part in a cultural dance, and learn how to play a game of *omweso*.

#### Namugongo and the Uganda Martyrs - https://www.ugandamartyrsshrine.org.ug/

Did you know that in June every year, hundreds of thousands of pilgrims congregate in Namugongo? Many walk from remote corners of East Africa to pay homage to the 22 Ugandan Christians who were executed for their faith in 1886 at Namugongo, a modern day site of pilgrimage and remembrance. June 3rd marks the Uganda Martyrs' public holiday. Visit the Uganda Martyrs' Museum and learn the heart-wrenching yet inspiring stories of these brave individuals.

Entry fees - UGX 10,000 for adults

Working Hours - 8:30 am - 5:30pm

Saturday and Sunday – Closed

**Distance from the conference venue**- Hilton Garden Inn - approximately 5 to 7 kilometers

Ascend the minaret for panoramic views of Kampala and admire the architectural grandeur of East Africa's largest mosque. Female visitors will be asked to cover their heads.

**Working Hours** - Monday to Thursday and Saturday to Sunday from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM. On Fridays, it is open from 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM and re-opens after Friday prayers from 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM

Set on a hilltop in spacious natural gardens to the north of the city, this architectural landmark building can be seen from all over Kampala. It's a serene spot and the first Baha'i House of Worship in Africa.

### **Local Currency exchange**

Uganda's official currency is the Ugandan Shilling (UGX). You can exchange USD or other major currencies at Entebbe International Airport upon arrival, or at authorised forex bureaus in Kampala. 1 USD = 3,502.4 UGX, 1 Euro -= 4,100.57 UGX and 1 GBP - 4,725.88 UGX
